June 6: Dublin - Killarney

Our first visit this morning is at the spectacular and archaeological site known as the Rock of Cashel. A collection of medieval ecclesiastical buildings set on an outcrop of limestone in the Golden Vale. Continue to Blarney where you can climb to the top of Blarney Castle to kiss the famed stone and acquire the gift of eloquence or as the locals say "the gift of the gab". Nearby Blarney Castle is the Blarney Woollen Mills, it's a busy spot but if you are in need a shopping fix there will be time to drop by. Continue on to Killarney, the town on the lakes and the elegant Malton Hotel that will be your home for the next 3 nights. Meet for a cocktail, followed by dinner.

• RING OF KERRY

Today we experience Ireland's most iconic scenic costal drive around the Iveragh Peninsula better known as the Ring of Kerry. On our journey we will see **Killorglin** set on **Dingle Bay**, which was the location for the film 'Ryan's Daughter'. We also see **Daniel**







O'Connell's Cahirciveen, the fishing village of Waterville, the Black Valley and Moll's Gap. Stop at Torc Waterfall for a chance to join a Local Specialist for a leisurely guided walk, taking you along the lakeshore and pass the farmland's of the Muckross Estate.

• DINGLE PENINSULA

The peninsula is dominated by the range of mountains that form its spine, running from the Slieve Mish range to Mount Brandon, Ireland's second highest peak. The coastline consists of steep seacliffs, broken by sandy beaches, with two large sand spits at Inch in the south and the Maharees to the north.

• JAUNTING CAR & MUCKROSS HOUSE

No trip to Killarney is complete without a Jaunting car ride to **Muckross House**. Departing from your hotel set out on the old Kenmare road passing the entrance to the Earl of Kenmare's Demesne. As you ramble along the pathways of the National Park, your horseman will not only point out all the places of interest he will also ensure this is a fun and memorable experience. Visit Muckross House a nineteenth century Victorian mansion set amid this stunning beauty and a focal point of the Park.

•Killeen Golf Course, Killarney Golf Club Co. Kerry, Ireland Killeen golf course is what the folks from Killarney like to think of as our pièce de resistance here at Killarney Golf Club. Transfers additional.

June 7: continued for everyone - EXCLUSIVE PRIVATE EVENT

Regroup this evening for a look back in time as you return to the Muckross Estate for an exclusive evening at **Quills Farmhouse**. On arrival you will be met by a Piper, the farm staff and their beautiful wolfhounds. You will then see a number of traditional Irish farmyard demonstrations. Including a Blacksmith at work, hand-milking a cow, butter making in the dairy, Sheepdog trials, Clydesdale Horses & carriage. This is thirsty work so there will be drinks stations set up in the farmyard. Later an Irish piper will call dinner and escort you down a short country lane to the Schoolhouse for dinner and the best of traditional Irish entertainment.

June 9: Killarney/Cliffs of Moher/ Limerick EXCLUSIVE PRIVATE EVENT

Traveling north, stop for a walk along the Cliffs of Moher. These iconic cliffs rise some 700 feet above the pounding Atlantic. A visit to the 'Atlantic Edge' exhibition is a must during your visit. This evening we bid farewell to the Emerald Isle in style as we attend an exclusive medieval banquet at Knappogue Castle. The Castle has been standing since 1467. The banquet is a fun and animated experience. You are greeted at the main door of the castle by the Earl's Butler and the Ladies of the castle where you proceed to the Dalcassian Hall. Mingle with the Castle Entertainers and savor a goblet of honey wine. Enjoy music of the harp and fiddle followed by medieval choral singing from the Ladies. The Earl's Butler wittily recounts the history of the Castle finishing by explaining the 'Rules of Chivalry' practiced at Knappogue Castle and the dire consequences of breaching them! Once all are seated in the banqueting hall, the newly instated Earl receives his sword of office and presides over the proceedings. While partaking of a sumptuous four course dinner with the finest wines, the Ladies of the Castle accompanied by Irish harp and fiddle will entertain you.
